Despite his devotion to the Islamic faith, Yusef's heart was empty and unsettled. After encountering Jesus in a dream, he began reading the Bible which helped him to find the answers he had been seeking for years – leading to God's truth, forgiveness and peace. Despite great risks, Yusef decided to follow Jesus. Since walking through regular discipleship sessions with one of VOMC's in-country ministry partners, this faithful brother in Christ has since expressed his faith by receiving water baptism and joining a local church. Today, he lives his faith with joy and lasting peace.

"Prior to studying in this program, I thought I was a Christian because my mother and father were believers. Yet, through this [training] program, I soon realized that I was Christian in name only. I have talked with other [church] leaders' wives who have experienced a similar understanding, and God has given us a vision to teach others also."

2025 Donation Summary

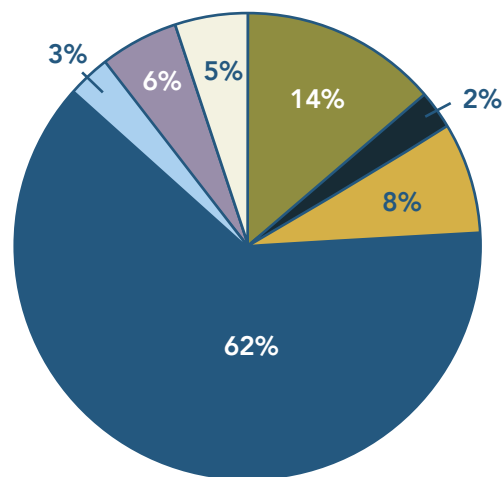
Thanks to your generosity and investment, we were able to support families facing persecution by providing both immediate relief and long-term spiritual encouragement.
