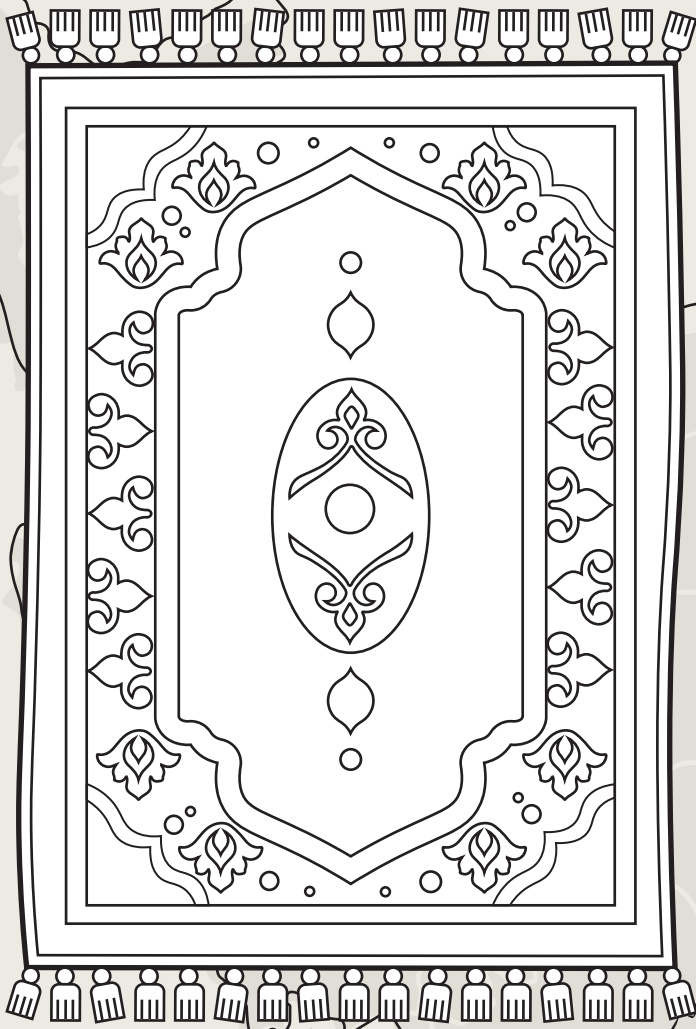


Table Talk IRAN
