7. _____ : A staple Korean delicacy consisting of spiced pickled cabbage.

8. _____ : The capital city of North Korea.

9. _____ : A term referencing the country's political ideology, which translated means "self-reliance." Deliberately built upon a distortion of the Bible, this ideology revolves around the people's worship of the ruling Kim family.

10. _____ : A carved or cast figure of a person or animal, especially one that is life-size or larger.
