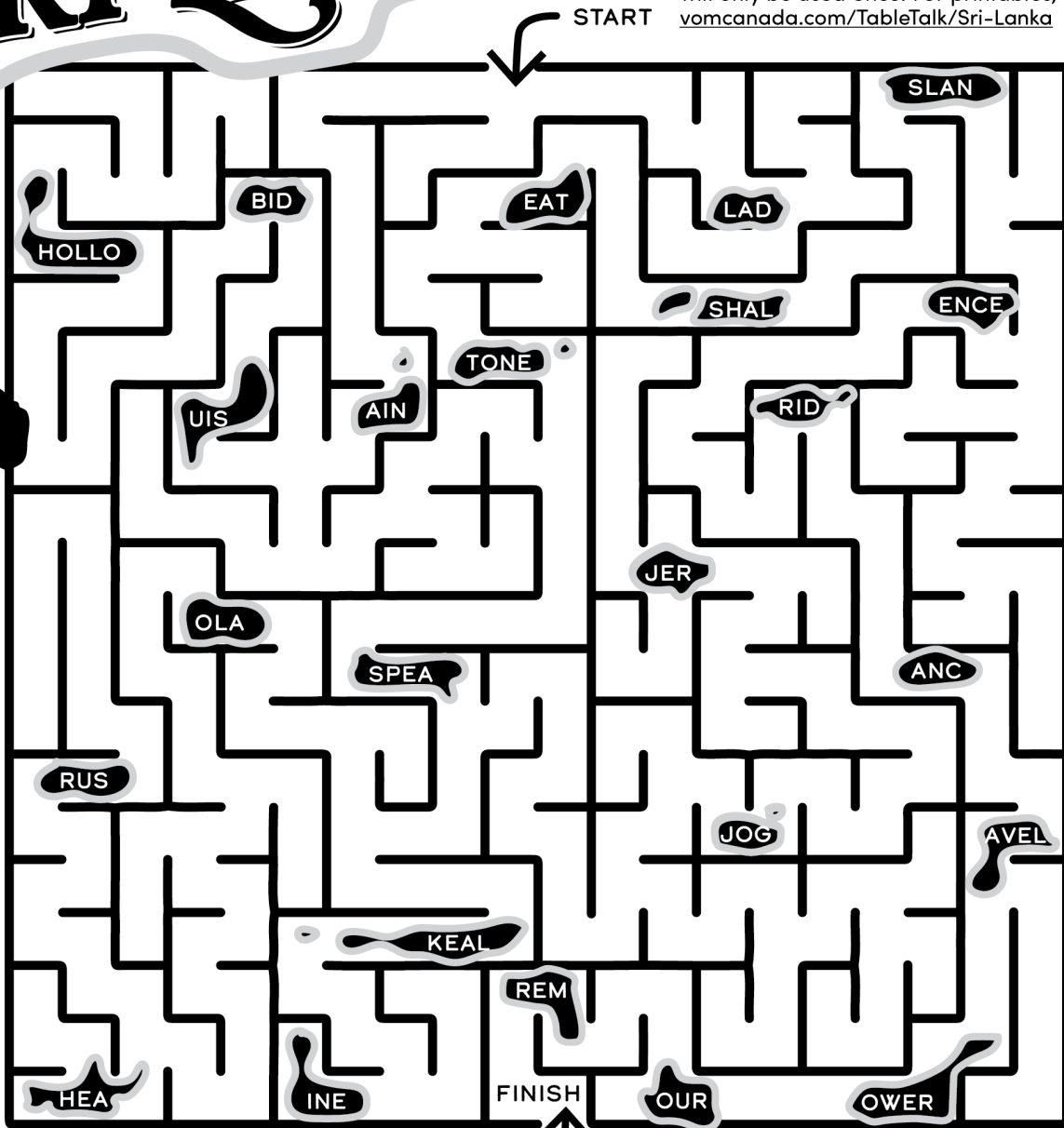

THE STORY OF THE BRIDGE:

Adam's Bridge is a ch___ of limes___ shoals (naturally occurring ridges of rock sediment) that over time has cr___ed a section of ___ low water between the coasts of India and Sri Lanka. Many of these shoals have formed dozens of small i___ds. Geological evid___ suggests that this natural 48-kilometre b___ge once connected India and Sri Lanka. ___ent records indicate that it was possible to tr___ across the bridge on foot until the 15th century, before it broke up during a p___ful storm. Today, many people visit these shoals for t___ism and religious ce___onies.
