INDIA: Anti-Conversion Legislation Expanding

The North Indian state of Uttarakhand is now the seventh state in the country to pass legislation restricting religious conversions, particularly from Hinduism to Christianity. This law carries a jail term of up to two years.

Passed by the state assembly in March, and signed into law by the governor in April, the law bans any conversion by use of force, fraud or inducement. The new law was passed in response to a High Court ruling last November which referred to conversion for the purpose of marriage a "sham." The court recommended a "Freedom of Religion Act" like that found in other Indian states.

Experience in various areas of India indicates that similar legislation has frequently been applied unjustly against Christians, particularly among those who are considered by Indian society as low-caste Dalit people. Unwarranted accusations are often used to harass and restrict Hindus from converting away from their religion. More about persecution in India may be [reviewed here](#).

RUSSIA: Church Attack in Chechnya

On Saturday, May 19th, four gunmen stormed the Archangel Michael Orthodox Church in Grozny, Chechnya. Before they were shot dead by police, they had killed one church member and two security officers. Two other officers and another church member were also injured.

According to the pastor, churchgoers heard shouts of "Allahu Akbar" outside the church and rushed to bolt the doors just as the attackers tried to break in. It appears that the attack started as a hostage attempt. Along with guns, the four perpetrators also carried axes and Molotov cocktails. The self-proclaimed Islamic State (ISIS) terrorist group has claimed responsibility.

Chechnya, which is located in southern Russia, has been a hotbed for Islamist activity – often attacking police, government officials and moderate Muslims. Militants have been attempting to establish a Muslim emirate in the region for years. The population is predominantly Muslim after most of the Christian population fled during the separatist wars of the 1990s.

Please remember the friends and families of those tragically killed in this attack. Pray for the healing of those injured and peace for members of the church who witnessed the violence. May the governing authorities act justly toward those responsible.

NIGERIA: Army Rescues Nearly a Thousand Captives

After a week-long battle, the Nigerian army has freed almost a thousand people from Boko Haram captivity. The operation led to the deaths of over 50 of the terrorists. According to the Nigerian military, the joint operation with the Cameroonian army remains ongoing.

Those rescued are mainly women and children, as well as some young men who had been forced to fight alongside the militants. The freed hostages have received necessary medical treatment. Praise the Lord for those released and continue to remember others remaining in captivity.
